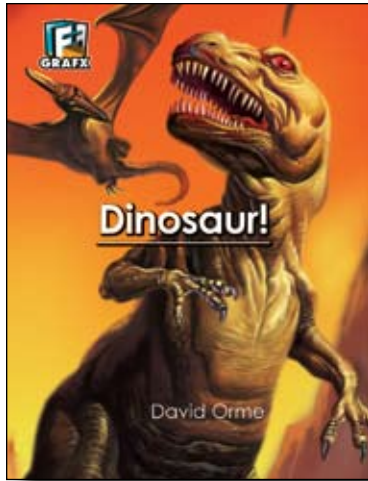

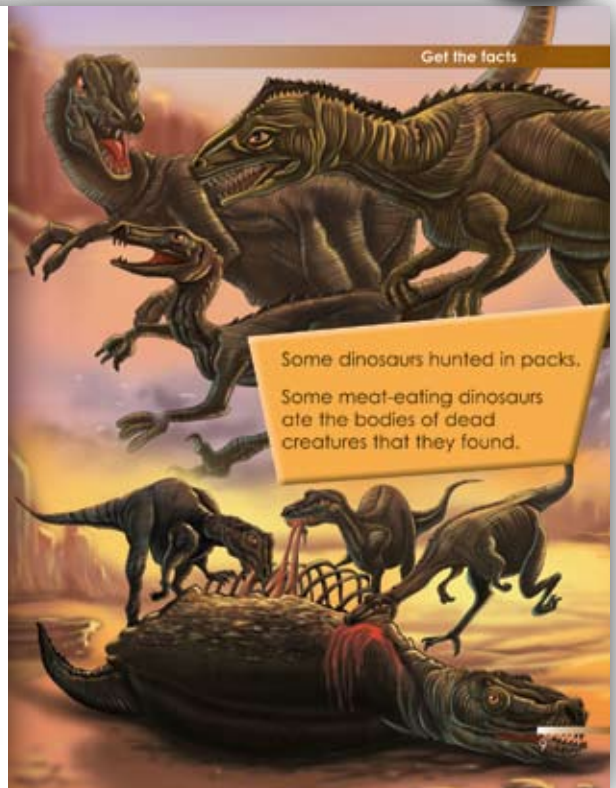

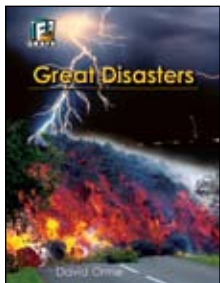

Sample pages from the *Dinosaur!* Student Book

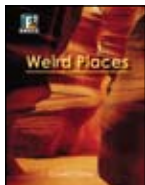
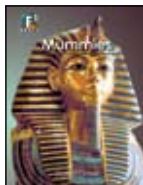
